Sunshine and Rain Poem



- 1. Brother Helping Brother a non-profit mission in Emery, Haiti runs a school with over 400 students. HCAW Supporters donated \$6,200.00 to help feed these children and for the families in Jeremie Haiti hit by an earthquake in 2021.
- 2. Jerusalem Baptist Church in Calhoun LA, serves unprivileged schools in the community making sure the schools have enough school supplies for the children. Supporters you donated \$1,600.00 to this effort.
- 3. Carson Christian School in Carson CA (students K- 12) their outreach to the community provides food, school supplies and tuition to needed families. Supporters you donated \$4,000.00 which blessed students that could not afford the tuition.
- 4. St John UM Church Los Angeles CA, serving the Watts Community with school supplies for needed children Supporters your donation of \$455.00 was a big help and was welcomed.
- 5. Mount Calvary Baptist Church, Fairfield, CA, Annual Community Backpack and School Supplies drive welcomed your support of \$1,000.00. which purchased 96 backpacks and school supplies filling the backpacks. Supporters, children were blessed.
- 6. True Love Baptist Church Fairfield, CA. serving the community feeding families during the Holiday Season, supporters your donations of \$300.00 helped with the feeding.
- 7. Apostolic Outreach Church Center New Orleans, LA, provided food, clean water to families in the surrounding areas after hurricane Ida September 2021. Your donations of \$2,000.00 blessed some of those families.
